PISD Libraries Pop-Up Libraries


Pasadena ISD is fortunate to have centralized Libraries and Instructional Materials department that services and supports Librarians and the district staff.

- Students log in to Sora at school easily through Classlink or download the app to a device.

Our Community of Readers is often impressed with the ease at accessing and using Sora and the wealth of reading materials available at ALL hours!









Curation and Promotion in Sora

PISD's community of readers have easy access to the most popular titles on their browsing page!






Curation and Promotion in Sora




Partnership with Harris County Public Library
