

ICD-10-PCS COURSE



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This course is offered as online continuing education for graduates of the Health Information Technology program and/or graduates of other CAHIIM Accredited HIT/HIM programs. The course will focus on how to transform narrative descriptions to build ICD-10-PCS procedure codes. The student will practice coding guidelines by applying the ICD-10-PCS codes to coding cases and scenarios. The course is taught by an AHIMA Certified ICD-10 Trainer. Participants earn AHIMA approved CE credits.

*If the student is not a graduate of the Hinds Community College HIT program, they will need to submit a copy of their diploma from any other CAHIIM Accredited HIM/HIT program along with the registration form and payment.
